- Explain how laws are made and changed in your country. Tell how people are chosen to lead the country. Give us a picture of your queen/king, president, prime minister and primary government building.



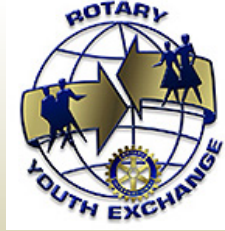
Economy of (your country)

- Picture 2 or 3 special tourist locations.

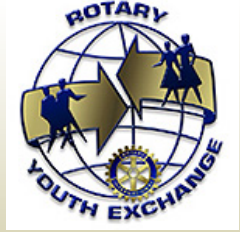

- Is your schedule the same every day?



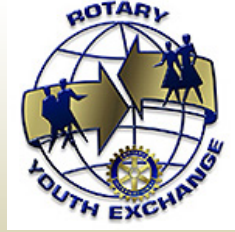
My Family

- Do you have any relatives who live near-by or with you?



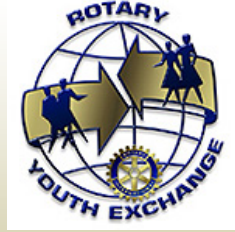

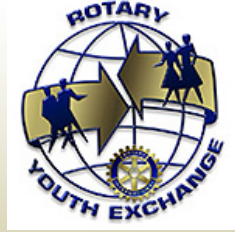

- How is it different to where you live now?



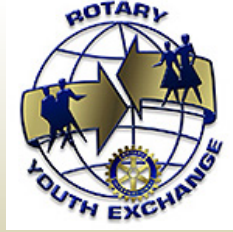
